



## Website

**If you don't yet have a website here's what you need to do:** *(note: these are just the basic steps to get you up and running.)*

- **Purchase your chosen domain name.** I cover this in the naming section. You can purchase your domain name through the same company that will hosting your website. It is very easy to do. *(See next point below)*
- **Purchase a hosting account.** This is where your new website and email will be kept. There are many to choose from such as **godaddy.com** or **bluehost.com** I use **tsohost.com** (all are easy to setup and usually a support staff member will you do it all for you over the phone).
- **Install WordPress onto your new hosting account.** Your hosting company support staff will do this for you it only takes a few minutes. Just ask them its part of the service. There are many other options for building your website but I find Wordpress is the easiest and most flexible.
- **Purchase a design theme for your new WordPress website.** Once your new WordPress website is setup you need a design for it. Wordpress does come with a few free themes but for a really professional design there are lots of inexpensive themes you can buy. I purchase my themes from **Themeforest**. You purchase them as a 'plugin' which you can then easily upload to your website *(ask me if you have any problems).*



- **Setup your new domain name email.** Once again you can do this inside of your new hosting account admin area. Your hosting company support team will usually do it for you if you ask them.
- **Setup up some pages on your new website.** To start add the following.
  - Homepage
  - About me
  - Contact details
  - Blog (if you want one)
  - Product page (if have products ready to sell)
  - Start writing some content for your new website
  - Upload some high quality images to support your text content. I have listed lots in my resource library (you will find a link in your course dashboard).
- **Upload your logo** to your website make sure it is on every page.
- **Setup a mailing list account.** There are many to choose from but I would recommend 'MailChimp' it's easy and it's free. Go to: [mailchimp.com](https://mailchimp.com)
- **Add a "subscribe now" button.** Add this button to your homepage so visitors can then subscribe to your new mailing list.
- **Add a link to your subscribe button on your social media pages.** This will make it easy for visitors to your Facebook ,Twitter, Instagram etc pages to sign up to your new mailing list.
